Steps

- You have to work in groups – two (three) students per group
- Select topic from the list or any subject you like. I would like to know which topic you have selected. Topics should be specific, similar in manner to the ones listed. Not more than one group per topic if possible.
- You will have to give an overview of 3-4 papers. The papers should discuss/use mathematical models for performance evaluations.
- You have to prepare a written report of 4-5 pages, comparing the selected papers (not just discussing them one after the other).
- Each project will be presented on the scheduled seminar in a talk of about 20 minutes.

Deadlines

1. Selected topic: or title of the study with a one paragraph explanation of the addressed research issue.
 2. List of selected papers: with one-two sentences per paper, explaining why the paper was selected.
 3. Outline: the main sections of the study with one-two sentence explanation per section. Maximum one page.
 4. Final report: should look like a conference paper with abstract, introduction,..., conclusions, list of references, max 5 pages.
 5. Presentation, 20 minutes, with slides
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1. Selected topic and contact person: Sept 27, Thursday
 2. List of selected papers: Oct 1, Monday
 3. Outline: Oct 4, Thursday
 4. Final report: Oct 9, Tuesday
 5. Presentation: Oct 11, Thursday

Grading

Group members get the same grade.

The grading will consider the following:

- topic selection motivation (0-2)
- the quality of the list of selected papers and explanation on why these papers were selected (0-5)
- the quality of the outline (0-3)
- the quality of the report, including content and language (0-5)
- the quality of the presentation, including content and presentation style (0-5)
