Language of instruction

The language of instruction is specified in the course offering information in the course catalogue.

Intended learning outcomes

The objective of the course is to give the students basic knowledge of the design process. On completing the course, the student shall be able to formulate questions and examine different methods and tools in order to solve problems around design processes.

Course contents

The concept of exformation is used in the course as a design issue. The process of design is a process of information, of form giving. Exformation is everything deliberately discarded by the "designer" in the form giving process. The course is thus focused on the "discarded information". Students explore this concept and develop a project with it.

Disposition

The course is carried out as a project, and it also contains lectures, seminars and exercises.

Examination

- PRO1 Project part 1, 4.5 credits, grading scale: P, F
- PRO2 Project part 2, 3.0 credits, grading scale: P, F
